How to read this chart

If a delegation has an 'O' in the grid, the nation has observer status in that committee. Observers may not vote on substantive issues, but are being included in the committee because of the committee structure or the topics themselves.

This grid has been created for quick and easy reference in order to see which countries are in a specific committee.

It also allows for advisors to quickly see the different size delegations that are offered at GTHSMUN.

For example, the grid for the United States allows the United States to send a minimum number of 11 delegates and a maximum number of 13 delegates. The United States is a member of the 6 general assembly committees, the Security Council, WHO, WTO, UNEP, and UNHCR. Security Council, Plenary, and OIC both allow a maximum of 2 delegates per delegation to be seated in their committees. All other committees only allow one delegate per delegation.
